Building Together: God's Church

Bible passages: Haggai 2.1-9 and 1 Corinthians 3.1-9

Introduction

Encouragement to:

- look forward to new thing God building
- accept his invitation to work with him and one another

The discouragement of comparison

- with what happened in the past; precious things remain but look different because different time, people and culture
- with what happening in other churches
- look for what God is doing now and join him in it

We are God's Church

- cp Haggai 2.4-5
- God is at work in Sunnyside and invite us to work with him to build his Church
- Work not strive: done with him and in his strength; he will provide the growth but we need to do our part

Work begins with our spiritual life

- We are God's temple where he lives by his Spirit
- Living stones which grow through relationship with him fed by prayer, worship, Bible reading and serving

"The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house," says the Lord Almighty. "And in this place I will grant peace," declares the Lord Almighty.' Haggai 2.9

- 6. How might God be inviting you to be part of what he is building in Sunnyside and in you?
- 7. Is there one thing that you are taking away from these passages? Is there something you need to do in response? It might be something to pray about, something to think more about, something God wants you to talk to someone about or something he wants you to do. Make a note of it so you don't forget!

"Be strong...and work. For I am with you", declares the Lord Almighty..."My Spirit remains among you. Do not fear'' (Haggai 2.4-5)
