Main points of the sermon

Today is Advent Sunday when we prepare for the coming of the Lord. The prophet Haggai has a message for us

The people were saying it's not time to rebuild the Temple in Jerusalem. It had been destroyed some 70 years earlier .

The Temple was in ruins and the peoples energies were spent on their own houses. Haggai warned that the poor harvests were a sign of their priorities. God would send a drought on their land. As a result they began to work on the temple.

Today's reading begins with a complicated argument about holiness. They can easily become defiled, but not always. There are hazards for us on our journey, but we can like the people of Haggai's day be rewarded. "Give careful though to your ways" "From this day I will bless you"

God's message was "I will make you like my signet ring" A signet ring is a pledge of full payment.

Haggai closes with the words from the Lord Almighty "I will make you like my signet ring, for I have chosen you".
